

Key Road Policies

- Earlier in 1998, the state government had come up with the Uttar Pradesh Road Development Policy with its main objective being to supplement government resources with private funds.
- The Uttar Pradesh Expressway (Levy of Tolls and Fixing of Fees and Realisation thereof) Rules, 2010 have been introduced to bring in transparency in tolling.
- The state government launched the Uttar Pradesh Road Safety Policy in 2014. It also created a Road Safety Fund with a corpus of Rs 1 billion.

Multilateral-funded Projects

World Bank-funded Uttar Pradesh Core Road Network Development Project (UPCRNDP)

- UPCRNDP was approved by the World Bank on March 29, 2019.
- Of the total project cost of \$570 million, World Bank will fund \$400 million in the form of loan. As of now, no disbursements have been made by the bank.
- The state PWD has identified 24,095 km of core road network (CRN) for the development.
- The UPCRNDP has four components road network development, institutional strengthening, road safety and contingency response.
- Road network component includes pavement strengthening, upgrading, and maintenance of about 500 km high priority state highway corridors, which are a part of the defined Core Road Network (CRN), at a cost of \$476 million. The component shall include civil works, rehabilitation and resettlement and associated consulting services and goods.
- The project is expected to close by June 30, 2025.
- Under state budget 2020-21, funds worth Rs 8.3 billion have been approved for the project.

ADB-funded Uttar Pradesh Major District Roads Improvement Project

- Approved in April 2016, the project will improve about 430 km of major district roads (MDRs) in the state, in line with the Strategic Core Road Network Master Plan for Uttar Pradesh.
- It will also involve upgradation of major district roads depending on traffic requirements, reconstruction, widening and strengthening culverts and bridges, and maintenance of improved road assets for a period of five years post completion.
- Further, road safety audit is expected to be taken up under the project on the MDRs and core road network in the state, and initiated remedial measures at critical locations
- Along with ADB's loan of \$300 million, the Uttar Pradesh government will provide counterpart support of \$128 million.
 The project will run for almost five years with an expected completion date of end-September 2021.
- As of June 2019, projects worth \$185.11 million have been awarded and ADB has disbursed funds worth \$88.08 million.
- Under state budget 2020-21, funds worth Rs 7.55 billion have been approved for the project.
